

# Page Proof Instructions

*Page proofs of your paper will be made available for your review. Please read them carefully and make any necessary corrections. The journal editors will not be responsible for errors that you overlook or fail to indicate clearly.*

## General Instructions

Corrected page proofs should be returned *within one week* to allow sufficient time for the editors and compositor to make any changes that you may find necessary. Sometimes even a short delay in providing corrections may delay publication to a later issue. Your paper will not be published until corrections have been received.

To avoid errors in the published paper, please check carefully all of the text, equations, numerical data, tables, figures, and figure captions. Please note that difficult or unreadable portions may have been retyped.

Please make all corrections clearly and legibly. Page proofs are provided for the purpose of correcting errors in copyediting or typesetting, or *minor* errors in the original manuscript, and not to provide an opportunity for extensive revisions. Please do not make any corrections that are contrary to the usual journal style.

*Special attention is needed when entering equations or extended characters.* Before submitting to the compositor, please verify that all special characters are displayed properly.

## How to Correct Text

Corrections should be entered in the corrections field in WriteTrack. Questions that have arisen during copyediting and typesetting are included for your special attention (Q1, Q2, Q3). You are responsible for addressing each query in the corrections field.

## How to Correct Figures

If there is an error in a figure, please e-mail or mail a new figure with the corrections. Please note that photographs will look much better in the printed journal than they do in the proofs.

Unless the layout posed special problems, figures have been placed as close as possible to where they were first mentioned. *All* figures must be cited in the text. Please be sure that figures and captions correspond correctly.

## Author's Alterations

When you check your proofs, *please make only changes that are urgently required.* Extensive changes can delay publication and may necessitate additional review by the technical editor.

## Providing Corrections

Please provide the corrections electronically *within one week* via WriteTrack.
